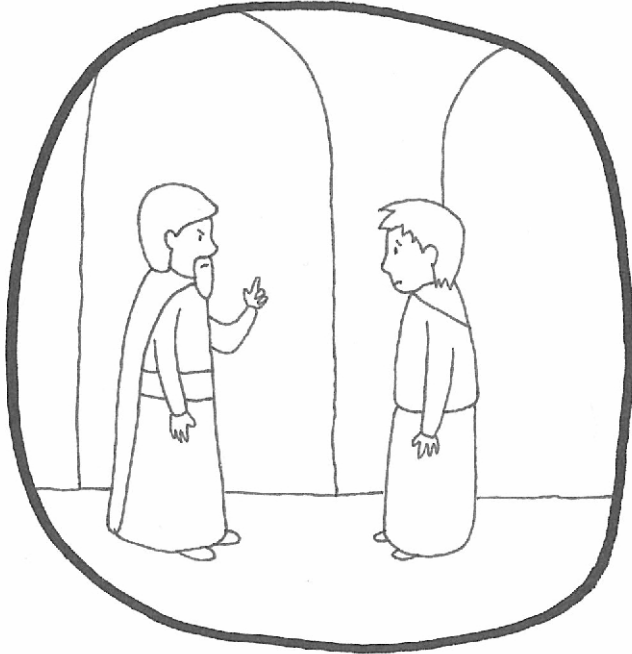

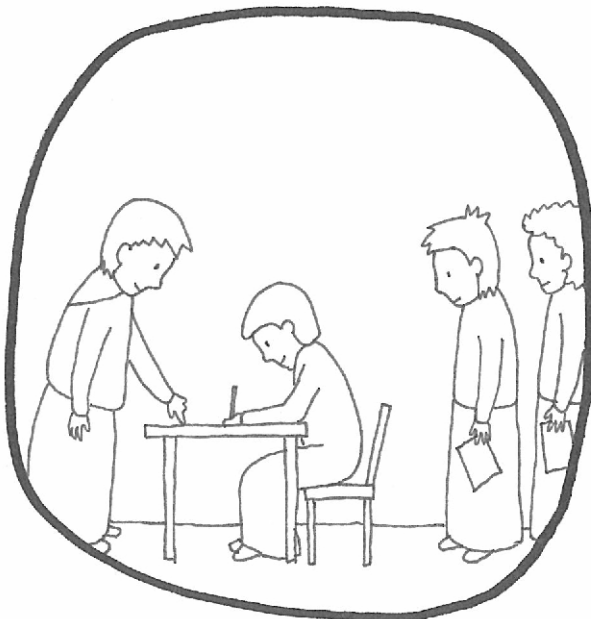
Luke 16:1-13



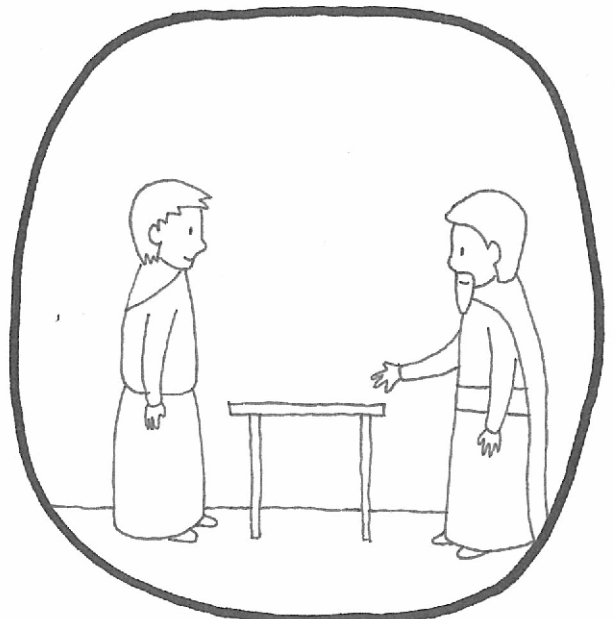

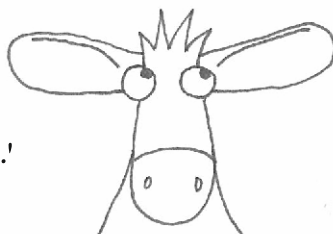
- ② The steward said to himself, 'What shall I do? I am not strong enough to dig and I am ashamed to beg.'

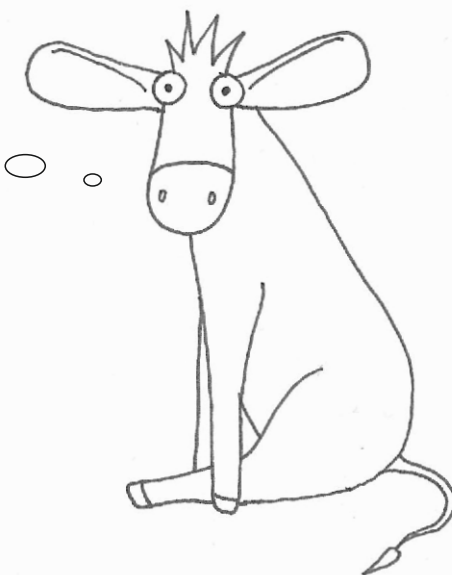


- ④ And the master commended that dishonest steward for acting prudently.
