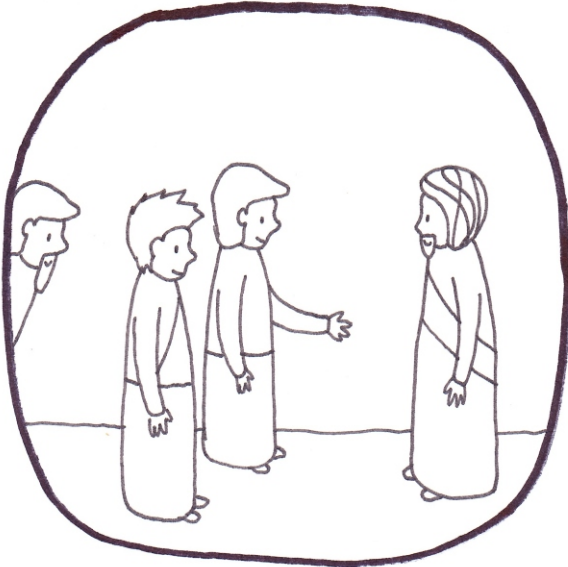


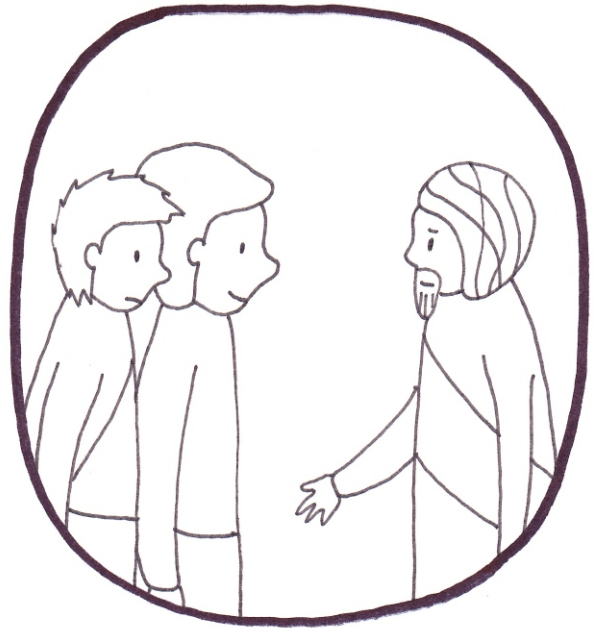

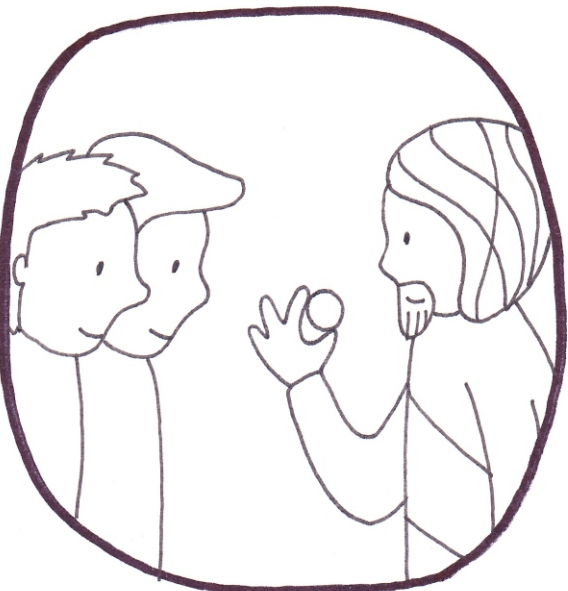

Matthew 22:15-21



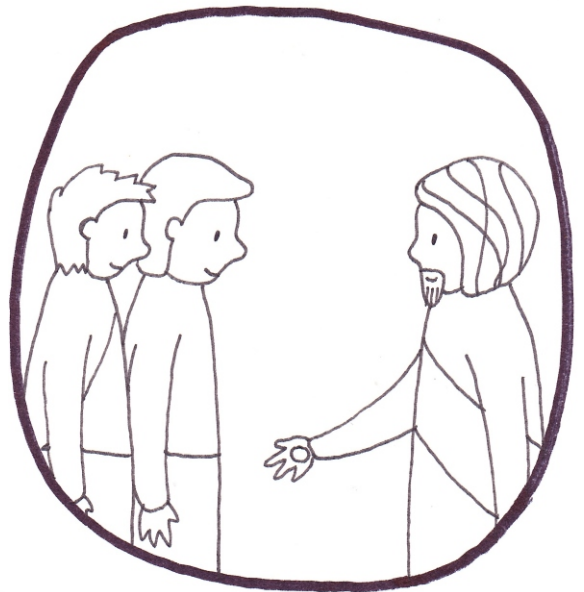

- ③ He said to them, "Whose image is this and whose inscription?" They replied, "Caesar's."



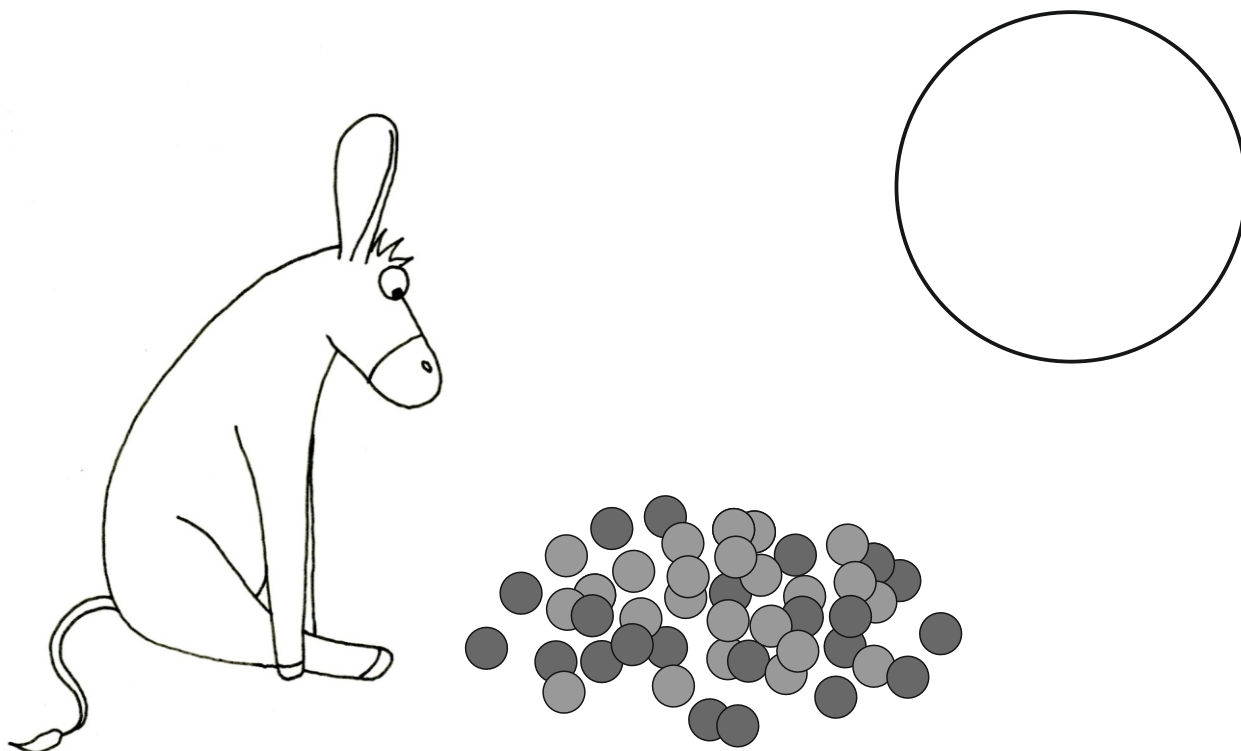
- ④ At that he said to them, "Then repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God."
