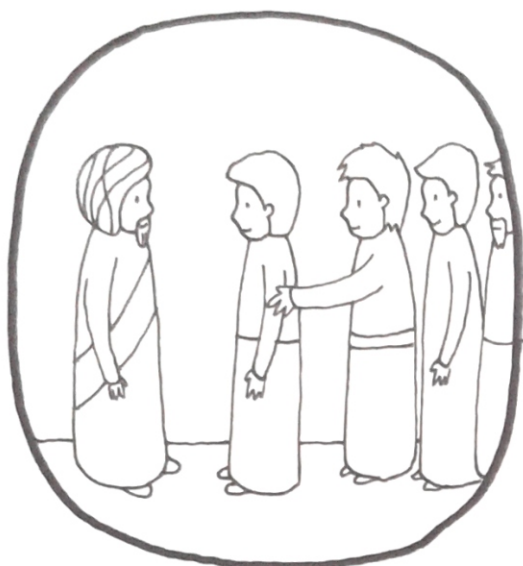


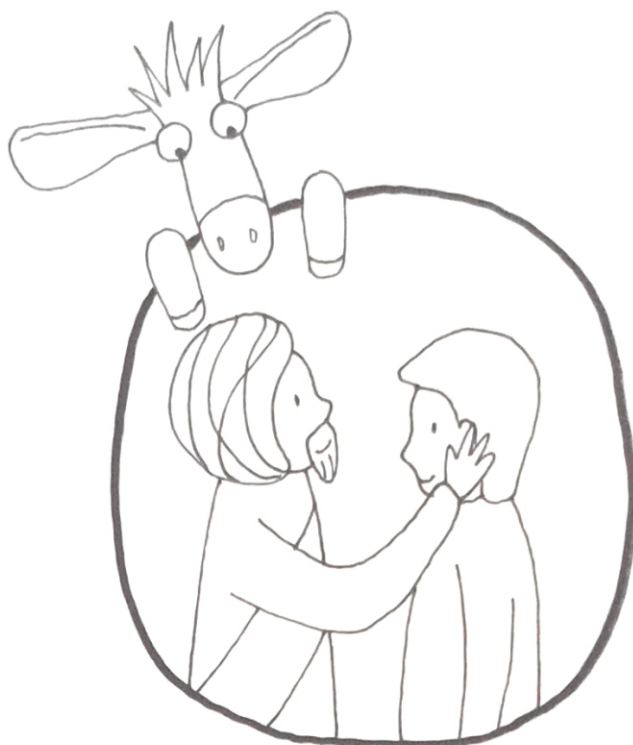

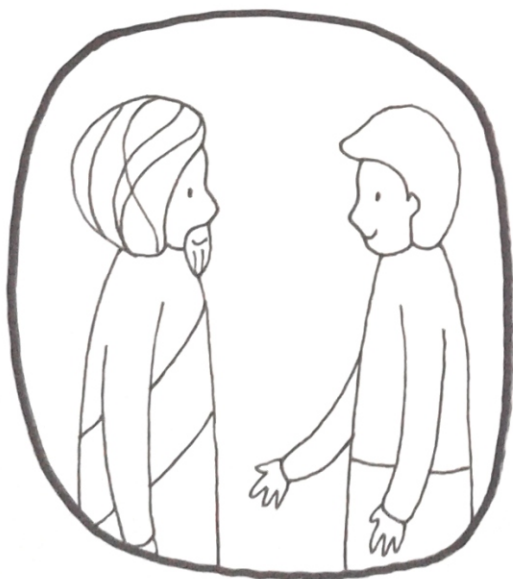
Gospel for children
